



The project "Implementation of innovative measures for mitigation and adaptation to climate change in municipalities in Bulgaria" is predefined and implemented by the National Trust Ecofund in partnership with the municipalities of Sofia, Plovdiv, Varna, Burgas, Kardzhali, Ruse, Stara Zagora, Sliven together with a norwegian partner- Norwegian Association of the Local and Regional governments (KS).

The innovative project aims to improve the capacity of local authorities to plan, monitor and implement specific measures to mix impacts and adapt to climate change. The project will support the 8 (eight) municipal authorities to assess their strategic plans and programs and applied measures so far for mixing and adapting to climate change, while identifying gaps and potential risks. These are the municipalities with the highest risk of natural disasters such as floods, elevations, fires or high temperatures, combined with elevations that cause stress. As a result, it will be possible to apply the most advanced knowledge, experience and pilot innovative urban planning measures. Also, the results and good practices will be widely disseminated in other bulgarian municipalities.

Predefined project №3 BGENVIRONMENT-4.001 "Implementation of innovative measures for mitigation and adaptation to climate change in municipalities in Bulgaria" has a total amount of financial assistance - 2,800,000 EUR, and the duration of project activities will be up to 42 months.
